4.	Candidates are advised to submit the online application much before the closing date and not to wait till the last date to avoid the possibility of disconnection/ inability or failure to login to the website on account of heavy load on the website during the closing days.
5.	Candidates should read the instructions in the advertisement and online application form carefully before making any entry or selecting any option.

2.	Mode of payment of the Application Fee is through Online.
3.	Fee is exempted for candidates belonging to SC, ST, PWD and Women category.
4.	The Application number will be generated after the submission of the application. Applicant is required to make the online payment of the application fee after submission of application.
